Team Green Events

Litter Law Enforcement Luncheon Held in March. Citizens are given the opportunity to receive information and updates on littering and recycling. Recognition is given to persons and organizations servicing the community in litter prevention.

Adopt-a-spot (March and October). Groups and organizations collect litter from the streets within the city limits.

Trash Bash (April). Citizens drop off items at collection stations in parking lot at Chennault Airport. Stations include scrap metal, oil and antifreeze, computer and other electronic devices, paint, automotive batteries, mercury and/or products containing mercury, tires, miscellaneous trash, and reusable items such as clothes and furniture. Household hazardous wastes are not accepted unless specifically noted.

Clean Campus Contest (April). Students volunteer their time to pick up litter, plant flowers, and greenery to beautify their campus. Committee members judge the contest and the winners receive awards and trophies.

Beach Sweep (Third Saturday in September). A worldwide event sponsored through the Ocean Conservancy's International Coastal Cleanup. Groups collect litter from the region's coast, inland waterways and shorelines.

Phone Book Recycling Contest Schools collect old phone books within a specific timeframe and take them to the Team Green Recycling Truck. The winners receive cash rewards.

Mercury Collection (Every Friday 9am-2pm). Residents bring products such as thermometers, thermostats, fluorescents lights, alkaline batteries, chemistry sets, and vials or jars of mercury to the Waste Water Division located at 1132 W. 18th Street.
