SUMMER DAY CAMP RULES

- 1. Campers **must** be picked up by 5:30 pm. If not picked up on time a fee of **\$10.00** for the first ten minutes and **\$10.00** every ten minute thereafter will be assessed and must be paid before the child/children can return to camp. (example: 5:31pm-5:40pm=\$10, 5:41-5:50=\$10, 5:51-6:00=\$10)
- Appropriate shoes, clothing & jewelry must be worn. Child will not be able to stay in camp if not appropriately attired.
 - Shoes **Tennis shoes only** (No flip flops, sandals, crocs, etc.)
 - Clothing No short shorts, oversized/sagging ripped/torn clothing. Our dress code is in accordance
 with Calcasieu Parish School policies. Shorts, slacks and other dress, appropriate for the climatic
 conditions or daily activities should exemplify your play wear.
 - Jewelry Boys; no earrings, Girls; no hoops/dangle earrings

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- 3. All items belonging to campers must be labeled. (Shoes, clothes, snack, bags, towels, etc.)
- 4. No electronic games, cell phones, MP3 players, etc., will be allowed at camp. The City of Lake Charles Recreation & Parks Dept., and/or its employees will not be responsible for theft or loss of these items.
- 5. All belongings are to be lined up in designated area.
- 6. Upon arrival, campers are to come in and sit down where assigned
- 7. When a whistle is blown, campers are to stop what they are doing **IMEDIATELY**, and pay attention to the Director/Counselors.
- 8. Campers are to go to assigned counselors when they need something or if something is wrong.
- 9. Campers are not allowed in **any** closet.
- 10. Snacks/drinks are to be eaten only during snack/drink time, not before or after.
- 11. When entering the cafeteria, campers are to enter **QUIETLY**. We are there to eat.
- 12. Campers are to answer their own name for roll call.
- 13. Campers are to remain with his/her counselor at all times.
- 14. No Horseplay or physical contact allowed, this includes but not limited to wrestling, pushing, chasing, hitting or hitting with an object, etc. Camper must notify Counselor if any occur.

- 16. No games are allowed on the bus. Campers are to be quiet so that the driver is alert at all times.

STATE OF LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT of EDUCATION Bulletin 1191 RULES for SCHOOL BUS RIDERS

A school bus with undisciplined passengers is a hazardous bus. The misbehavior of the students can lead to accidents. The driver must concentrate on the driving task at hand and cannot be expected to constantly discipline the students while the bus is in motion. A student's behavior on the school bus should be no different than in a classroom. Therefore, for the safe operation of the school bus, students should be aware of and obey the following safety rules:

- 1. Cooperate with the bus driver; your safety depends on it.
- 2. Be on time; the bus will **NOT** wait.
- 3. Cross the road cautiously under the direction of the bus driver when boarding and leaving the bus.
- 4. Follow the bus driver's instructions when loading and unloading.
- 5. Remain quiet enough not to distract the driver.
- 6. Have written permission and be authorized by the Principal to get on or off at a stop other than the designated stop.
- 7. Remain seated at all times when the bus is in motion.
- 8. Keep arms, head or other objects inside the bus at all times.
- 9. Refrain from throwing objects in the bus or out of windows and doors.
- 10. Use emergency exits only for emergencies, and when instructed to do so.
- 11. Refrain from eating or drinking on the bus.
- 12. Avoid use or possession of tobacco, matches, cigarette lighters, obscene materials, weapons, drugs or other prohibited items on the bus.
- 13. No glass objects or other objects allowed on the bus if prohibited by state or federal or local school board policies.
- 14. No band instruments, projects and other objects too large or too hazardous to be held by the passenger or stowed safely under the seat will be permitted on the bus.
- 15. Refrain from damaging the bus in any way.
- 16. Remove or secure any drawstrings on clothing or book bags to prevent injury to yourself or others.
- 17. Be courteous and safety conscious. Protect your personal riding privilege and enjoy the ride.

- 6. Users will log off personal accounts after use.

- 7. Users are not allowed to install software or download from websites.
- 8. Users will not attach any hardware such as wireless devices without permission.
- 9. Users should expect no privacy of the contents of personal files and email on the system. Messages relating to, or in the support of, illegal activities must be reported to the authorities.
- 10. Misuse of the system can result in possible legal action and/or prosecution, and will require restitution for costs associated with system restoration, hardware, or software cots.
- 11. Users bringing illegal and/or inappropriate materials into the system's electronic environment will be subject to disciplinary action.
