

NOTICE TO PROPOSERS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana, will receive sealed proposals until 2:45 P.M., April 4, 2017 in the office of the Clerk of the Council, City Hall, 326 Pujoe Street, 4th Floor, Lake Charles, Louisiana: they subsequently will be opened and read for the following:

Transit System Study – City of Lake Charles, LA

All proposals will be evaluated on criteria such as firms overall compliance with product specifications and project requirements based on firm capabilities, reference checks and description of key personnel utilized and qualifications, experience with similar projects of comparable systems in comparison with cities of similar size in transit, sensitivity to local and regional area immediate growth and potential to appraise the transit system with respect to transit operations and current rolling stock versus future rolling stock needs, and ability to understand FTA Fast Act implementation and future performance measures as specifically defined in the RFP document. The maximum total points for each proposal are set at 100 points.

All of the above according to specifications on file in the Office of Central Purchasing, City Hall, 6th floor, 326 Pujoe St., Lake Charles, Louisiana 70601.

All proposals must be submitted on PROPOSAL FORMS. Paper requests for proposals may be obtained in the Office of Central Purchasing.

All proposals MUST be plainly marked on the outside of the sealed envelope with the appropriate proposal numbers: “PROPOSAL FOR RFP #_____and FILE ID #_____.”

No proposals will be accepted after the above time and date. All proposals will be publicly opened and read, and canvassed in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Lake Charles, Louisiana, on April 4, 2017 at 3:00 P.M.

The City of Lake Charles reserves the right to accept or reject any and all of the proposals and to waive formalities and technicalities. In the event any two or more of the proposals submitted are equal, the City in its discretion may select the party to whom the contract shall be granted.
