The Lake Charles Community Band and conductor Leo Murray will also take the stage featuring a salute to the U.S. Armed Forces and a sing-a-long with the Louisiana Choral Foundation and friends. If inclement weather prevails, the program will be moved to the Civic Center Coliseum. The fireworks extravaganza will begin at 9:15 p.m. Tune into Gator 99.5 FM for the soundtrack simulcast.



Mayor Randy Roach invites you to Join the **Red White Blue & You** *Street Parade* 6pm, Monday, July 4th, 2011



- 1. Line up will begin at 4:30 pm on Mill Street, facing the east. The parade will turn right heading south on Ryan to Broad; turn left on Broad to Bilbo; right on Bilbo to Pujo; right on Pujo, concluding at the corner of Pujo and Lakeshore Drive.
- 2. Parade line up is first come, first placed. There will be no line up numbers. Parade volunteers will give you directions once you enter Mill street from the west (facing east).
- 3. Entries should arrive at the parade prepared with throws and decorations. Cars will not be allowed to make deliveries to particular floats, cars, etc. REMEMBER TO HAVE PLENTY OF WATER FOR YOUR PARTICIPANTS!!
- 4. Park your parade float, truck, car, etc. and stay with the parade unit. Do not leave your vehicle unattended.
- 5. This is a family-oriented event. Float music must be approved prior to the start of the parade, must not be indecent, and must be at an acceptable level of volume. Indecent clothing or behavior will not be permitted.
- 6. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on parade units (floats).
- 7. Only approved throws will be allowed. Approved throws include the following: Individually wrapped candy, doubloons, plastic cups and beads. Other throws differing from the above mentioned, must be approved prior to the start of the parade.
- 8. This is a non-stop parade. Do not stop along the route to perform.
- 9. Entry forms are due by Friday, July 1.
- 10. Maximum parade unit height is 14 feet. No exceptions.
- 11. All horses in the parade must have a sack/bag to collect feces.
- 12. City of Lake Charles street sweepers will follow immediately after the parade in an effort to help keep our city clean. Please discard all "trash" and boxes in appropriate trash receptacles after the parade.
