ORDINANCES FOR FINAL ACTION

25. 85-13 An ordinance approving the final agreement between the City of Lake Charles and Lake Charles Mardi Gras Boardwalk, LLC for the sale of the Pinnacle property and the parking garage

Sponsors: Dana Carl Jackson and Stuart Weatherford

Without objection, this item was considered first on the agenda.

Mr. Loftin stated that he summarized the Agreement for the Purchase and Sale of Property between the City and Lake Charles Mardi Gras Boardwalk, LLC (LCMGB) which had been previously submitted to the Council and most recent draft presented to the Council at the beginning of the Council meeting which included clerical revisions and revisions regarding sound levels. Mr. Loftin reviewed and outlined the summary of the agreement. Mr. Jackson made a motion to reinsert all of the issues related to the permitted sounds to 85 decibels along with all of the time frames and other references to the permitted sound levels. The motion was seconded by Stuart Weatherford. Mr. Simien commented on the decibel levels. Charles Landry, with Jones, Walker Law Firm, 8555 United Plaza, Baton Rouge, LA, who represents LCMGB, spoke regarding the agreement and answered questions from the Council.

Mr. Eckard called for a vote to give *Mr.* Landry additional time to speak. On a motion made by Dana Jackson, seconded by Luvertha August passed by the following vote:

Gary Dixon, 2334 Cherokee St., Baton Rouge, LA representing LCMGB, answered questions from the Council.

Mr. Loftin continued to review the summary and recommended an amendment to add to Section 4a.(1) The purchaser shall also provide a report with the Updated Master Plan from a certified acoustical engineer describing the Phase One Improvements which will address the mitigation of adverse impact on neighboring properties from the sound emitting from the Amphitheater and other Outdoor Venue activities.

Mr. Loftin recommended amending the Definition to read: "Project Planner" which means Architects Southwest with Steve Oubre as Principal Planner. However, if for any reason Steve Oubre is unable to or refuses to do the project a Licensed Architect with Smart Code experience, approved by the City, may serve a principal planner.

Mr. Loftin then recommended an amendment to state to authorize Billy E. Loftin, Jr. to make clerical changes and nonsubstantive changes and also changes for procedural issues.

He asked that the draft agreement dated February 20, 2013 (4:30p.m.) be made a part of the ordinance.
