A Statistical Analysis On Crime In Lake Charles



The Lake Charles Police Department classifies criminal offenses into three crime categories:

- Crimes Against Persons (murder, rape, robbery, and assault and battery)
- Crimes Against Property (burglary, larceny-theft, motor vehicle theft, and arson)
- Other Criminal Offenses (criminal damage, disturbing the peace, drug offenses, DWI, etc.)

### **Overall Criminal Offenses**

During 2012, there were 9,952 investigations of either felonious or simple misdemeanor offenses. This overall figure of criminal offenses was 263 offenses less that the total number of offenses investigated during the previous year, 2011.

### Crimes Against Persons

There were 1,546 offenses reported last year as Crimes Against Persons. This total was less than the total reported during the previous year, which was 1,630. This produced a 5% decrease in this crime classification.

### Crimes Against Property

Last year, there were 24 fewer property crimes reported as compared to the previous year. There were 5,140 property crimes recorded during 2012 and 5,164 offenses during 2011. This resulted in a 1% decrease in total property crimes.

### Crime Clearance Rate

The Lake Charles Police Department solves crimes when either an arrest of the offender is made, or by exceptional means (when elements beyond law enforcement control prevent the agency from placing formal charges against the offender), or due to lack of cooperation by victims or witnesses.

### Overall Clearance

Of the 9,952 criminal offenses investigated last year, 53% of these crimes were classified as solved. This figure was slightly below the previous year's clearance rate of 54%.

### Crimes Against Persons Clearance
