## **Electrical Permit Requirements:**

- \$7,500 Contractors Bond on City of Lake Charles Bond form. This form is on the city website at <u>www.cityoflakecharles.com</u>
   Go to:
  - o Departments
  - o Click Permit Center
  - o Then under Forms/Applications
  - o Select Bond Form
- 2. **Certificate of General Liability Insurance –** minimum of \$100,000 coverage
  - o City of Lake Charles **MUST** be listed as certificate holder
- 3. **To register for Sales Tax**, contact Calcasieu School Board Sales and Use Tax Department in Lake Charles at (337) 217-4280 ext. 3423
- 4. **Occupational License** Contact occupational license account representative located at City Hall, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, for more information call (337) 491-1442.
- 5. City or State of Louisiana License is required
  - Contact Louisiana Licensing Board for Contractors at (225)765-2301
    or (800) 256-1392
- 6. Application to qualify as Electrical Contractor is required
- 7. Application to qualify as a Journeyman Electrician:
  - A letter of reference and recommendation from previous employer is **REQUIRED**.
- 8. **Picture I.D.** of Master Electrician is required.
- 9. **Registration Fees**:
  - o First time registration fee for Master Electrician \$100.00
  - o Renewal fee for Master Electrician \$50.00
  - o Journeyman Electrician \$5.00 per person
  - o Apprentice \$3.00 per person
- 10. The City of Lake Charles requires **ALL** Electrical Contractors to be licensed with the city regardless of the cost of the job.
