The 150th Sesquicentennial Veterans Bricks are now available at a cost of \$150 per brick. A list of veterans represented on these comemorative 150th bricks will be placed in the Sesquicentennial Time Capsule to be buried soon.

Engraving Information:

Only one character (letter, number, punctuation mark) or space per block. Position or center name and information exactly as you want it to appear on the brick. Each brick can have up to 3 lines with as many as 14 characters per line. For additional bricks use a separate application. You may copy this form. (Can include rank, unit, dates, etc)
