## LAKE CHARLES RECREATION AND PARKS YOUTH LEAGUE BASKETBALL SUMMER 2018

#### I. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The governing rules will be the current rules of the National Federation of High Schools with the exceptions listed below and the City of Lake Charles Recreation and Parks Athletic Programs Operating Code.

#### Age Requirements:

5-6 year old league (Coed)
7-8 year old league (Coed)
9-10 year old league
Cannot be 7 on or before September 1, 2018.
Cannot be 9 on or before September 1, 2018.
Cannot be 11 on or before September 1, 2018.
Cannot be 13 on or before September 1, 2018.
Cannot be 15 on or before September 1, 2018.
Can not be 15 on or before September 1, 2018.
Can not be 17 on or before September 1, 2018.

3. It is the coach's responsibility to ensure that all players on his/her roster are of proper age.

Coaches must have a copy of each player's birth certificate at each game or player will not be able To play that game regardless if he is on roster or not.

#### 4. Roster Maintenance:

A team roster may consist of a maximum of 15 players and a minimum of 10 players.

The last day to add a player to the team's roster will be Monday, June. 22nd, 2018...

#### 5. Jersey

All players are required to wear shirts of like color, with a 6" number on the front and back.

Jersey numbers must use digits 0-5 only.

#### 6. Practice

Practice time may be scheduled through the family recreation centers.

No more than one practice can be scheduled in advance.

Practices will be for one hour and will be half court.

#### II. PLAYING RULES

#### 1. <u>Player and Game Equipment:</u>

In the 5-8 year old leagues, an eight foot goal will be used.

In the 9-10 year old league and above a ten foot goal will be used.

Players are required to wear non marking athletic shoes made of canvas or soft leather without any kind of cleat.

If two teams wear jerseys to a game that are similar in color, the visiting team will have to wear pennies during the game. The LCRP will supply the pennies.

#### Game Balls:

5-8 year old: Rookie Size Basketball (25.5"x26.25")
9-10 year old: Intermediate Size Basketball (28.5"x29")
11-18 year old: Official Size Basketball (29.5"x30")

#### 5. <u>9-18 Year Old Leagues:</u>

Games will consist of 4, 6-minute quarters (stop time).

If a team has a 15 point or greater lead, that team may not full court press.

No overtime, if final score ends in a tie, the game shall be recorded in the standings as a tie.

#### 6. <u>Time outs and Intermissions:</u>

Each team will be permitted 2 time outs per half.

There a will be a 5 minute halftime between the second and third quarters.

#### 7. <u>Starting Games:</u>

A team must have at least 4 players to begin a game but must have at least 5 players before the beginning of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter.

Coaches need to have teams ready to play at least 15 minutes before game time.

In the event a team has to forfeit a game, the game can still be played with officials, timer, and score keeper. However, the game will still go in the books as a loss for the forfeiting team.
