Street Closures

DOWNTOWN: Street parking will not be allowed on Ryan Street, between Pine and Kirby, from 8 a.m. Friday, Feb. 21, through Tuesday, Feb. 25 at the conclusion of the Krewe of Krewes Parade. The on-street parking areas will be barricaded. Additionally Ryan Street between Kirby and Gill Streets will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction beginning at 8 a.m. Friday, Feb. 21 through Tuesday, Feb. 25, at the conclusion of the Krewe of Krewes Parade.

Barricades will be placed on the route from Gill Street south to Sale on Tuesday morning, Feb. 25.

On Tuesday, Feb. 25, traffic along Ryan Street, south of Sallier Street, will be restricted to one lane each way, until around 2:30 p.m. when the road will be closed until after the Krewe of Krewes parade.

DOWNTOWN: Approximately one hour before the Second Line Stroll Walking Parade at 1 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 25, Ryan Street, between Pryce and Sallier, will be closed and will remain closed to vehicular traffic until after the Krewe of Krewes parade is concluded.
