THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTIONS MAY BE ADOPTED BY CONSENT

- 1. 189-21 A resolution authorizing the City of Lake Charles to issue a Request for Proposals to hire a Program Manager to identify, prioritize and manage multiple projects involving cleaning, restoring, repairing and improving the above-ground and below-grade drainage within the City.
- 2. 190-21 A resolution authorizing the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana, to proceed with development of a financing and borrow from the Louisiana Local Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority not to exceed \$20,000,000 in one or more series, taxable and/or tax exempt, for a term of not exceeding twenty (20) years, at a rate or rates not exceeding five (5%) percent per annum, for financing drainage and drainage improvements; employing bond counsel and other professionals; authorizing execution of the bond purchase or placement agreement in connection with issuance, sale and delivery of the bonds; authorizing application to the Louisiana Local Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority and the Louisiana State Bond Commission; and providing for other matters with respect thereto.

3. 191-21 Introduction of an ordinance amending the Operating and Capital Budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year relative to emergency drainage cleaning needed and to address ongoing flooding caused by Hurricane Laura storm debris hindering proper drainage throughout the citywide drainage system.
