Overall Progress Narrative:

During the second quarter of 2024the City has continued working mainly on its' Policy and Procedures documents for its' Affordable Rental and Economic Revitalization programs. Like the first quarter, this included multiple meetings with its' prospective sub-recipients, HUD staff, its' HUD-provided Technical Assistance (TA) Provider and the Louisiana Housing Corporation (LHC).

During this performance period, the City added two new employees to its Community Development staff as required by HUD to fill gaps in staffing capacity. They are currently working on the City's Economc Revitalization and Public Facilities projects. The TA provider traveled to Lake Charles in the last week of June and held a two-day training session for all nine (9) City staff members that will have responsibility working on these CDBG-DR projects.

The City expended \$73,136.40 on Adminstration and Project Delivery during this performance period and will complete its' first draw in the third quarter of the year.

Narrative:

Like the first quarter of the year, a substantial amount of time was spent on developing the Housing Policy and Procedures document. In mid-April, the TA Provider began requesting certain other documents related to the project such as the City's Cooperative Endeavor Agreement (CEA) with LHC and LHC's pro-formas for each project. LHC found that the CEA lacking certain specific information and that the pro-formas needed to be revised to show what the City's CDBG-DR funds would be used for on each project.

In early May, the TA provider suggest the City have a discussion with LHC about LHC becoming a sub-recipient to the City where a CEA wouldn't be necessary. Initially, LHC rejected the idea but reversed its' decision in early June and began working on a sub-recipient agreement in late June. The City is expecting the sub-recipient agreement from LHC in July. LHC also agreed to revise the pro-formas. The City also expects to finalize the Housing Policy and Procedure document in July.
