



CITY OF LAKE CHARLES PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Lake Charles, in conformance with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, will make available to the public for review, the 2017 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER).

The CAPER provides information on Housing and Community Development activities under taken by the City of Lake Charles for the 2017 program year, October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018. The CAPER includes activities funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the Home Investment Partnership (HOME) program and state-funded Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) Program. The purpose of the CAPER is to document how the City of Lake Charles spent federal funds on housing and community development and to assess whether or not the City made progress in meeting the needs of the community, as stipulated in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan. The CAPER will be at the following locations for review from December 3, 2018 to December 17, 2018 for citizens' comments and input:

- City Hall, 5th Floor, 326 Pujo St.
- Martin Luther King Center, 2009 North Simmons
- City of Lake Charles Transit Center, 1155 Ryan Street

The document will be submitted to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development no later than December 28, 2018.
