The City of Lake Charles, in conformance with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, will make available to the public for review, the 2018 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER).

The CAPER provides information on Housing and Community Development activities under taken by the City of Lake Charles for the 2018 program year, October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019. The CAPER includes activities funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the Home Investment Partnership (HOME) program and state-funded Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) Program. The purpose of the CAPER is to document how the City of Lake Charles spent federal funds on housing and community development and to assess whether or not the City made progress in meeting the needs of the community, as stipulated in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan.
