Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Lake Charles will conduct a Special Meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 3, 2020, in the City Council Chambers, 326 Pujoe St., to consider the matters on the Special Meeting Agenda attached hereto.

Pursuant to the proclamations issued by the Governor of the State of Louisiana, this Special Meeting will be held by both in-person and teleconference means. In further observance of the Governor's proclamations, access to the City Council Chambers will be limited to adhere to the capacity and social distancing requirements of the Governor's proclamations which is 25% of its maximum capacity (28 people) and adequate social distance must be maintained at all times. Those wishing to attend are permitted to do so; however, you are advised that the City of Lake Charles will strictly adhere to the Governor's proclamations.
