



DECLARATION OF EXTREME PUBLIC EMERGENCY

Due to the catastrophic impact and effects of Hurricane Laura throughout Southwest Louisiana, including the City of Lake Charles, a state of extreme public emergency exists effective Thursday, August 27, 2020, and will remain in effect until further notice. This declaration is made pursuant to *La.R.S. 38:2212.P(1)(a), et seq.*, and Chapter 7 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lake Charles which suspends the provisions of any regulatory ordinance prescribing the procedures for the conduct of local business, or the rules or regulations of any local agency which would in any way hinder or delay necessary action in coping with the disaster emergency.
