- 1. 327-2020** Appoint chairman to review bids for Project No. CP3362 2020 Lift Station Rehabilitation - Claire Gardens and Sowela.

ORDINANCES FOR FINAL ACTION

- 2. 315-2020** An ordinance providing for a one-time special exception to the enforcement of Sec. 3-33 of the Code of Ordinances and further providing for the suspension of the assessment of the delinquency penalties related to the late filing of a renewal application for an alcoholic beverage dealer's permit from November 01, 2020 to January 01, 2021.
- 3. 324-2020** An ordinance providing for a one-time special exception to the enforcement of Sec. 12-2 of the Code of Ordinances suspending the assessment of the delinquency interests and penalties related to the late payment of occupational license taxes from the March 01, 2021 deadline to April 01, 2021 and further providing for the reduction of the occupational license renewal taxes for 2021. (Est. cost \$150,000.00)

4. **325-2020** An ordinance authorizing the City of Lake Charles to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement with Catholic Charities to fund a water/sewer utility service bill payment assistance program managed by Catholic Charities for the benefit of the customers of City of Lake Charles utilities who were adversely affected by COVID-19.
5. **326-2020** An ordinance of the City Council for the City of Lake Charles providing for a temporary suspension of the collection of the City of Lake Charles' bus fares as fixed pursuant to Sec. 22-1 and Sec. 22-1.1 of the Code of Ordinances from December 17, 2020 to February 28, 2021.
6. **328-2020** An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of Lake Charles to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement that grants economic incentives to AA Billiards for the construction of a retail store within the Enterprise Boulevard Economic Development District.
7. **339-2020** Introduction and final action of an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 18784 passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana on October 7, 2020 as amended by Ordinance No. 18792 passed and adopted on November 4, 2020 to extend the emergency ordinance for Hurricane Laura through March 31, 2021.
8. **340-2020** Introduction and final action of an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 18780 passed and adopted on October 7, 2020 as amended by Ordinance No. 18793, passed and adopted on November 4, 2020, extending the suspension of Section 2-29(a) of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana through March 31, 2021.
