

## NOTICE TO PROPOSERS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana, will receive sealed proposals until 2:45 P.M., November 5, 2024 in the office of the Clerk of the Council, City Hall, 326 Pujol Street, 4th Floor, Lake Charles, Louisiana: they subsequently will be opened and read for the following:

Project Management and Administrative Services for the FEMA Disaster Recovery Programs and Other Federally or State Funded Initiatives

All proposals will be evaluated on criteria such as firm's capacity to address the scope of services; demonstration of firm's prior experience in providing consulting services, especially the firm's experience with FEMA programs; emphasis of all personnel and their FEMA experience in representing the City in recovery grant management and administration; small entrepreneurship (MBE/SBE/WBE) initiative; financial proposal; and other criteria more specifically defined in the RFP document. The maximum total points for each proposal are set at 100 points.

All of the above according to specifications on file in the Office of Central Purchasing, City Hall, 6<sup>th</sup> floor, 326 Pujol St., Lake Charles, Louisiana 70601.

All proposals must be submitted on PROPOSAL FORMS. Paper requests for proposals may be obtained in the Office of Central Purchasing.

All proposals MUST be plainly marked on the outside of the sealed envelope with the appropriate proposal numbers: "PROPOSAL FOR RFP # \_\_\_\_\_ and FILE ID # \_\_\_\_\_."

No proposals will be accepted after the above time and date. All bids will be publicly opened and read, and canvassed in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Lake Charles, Louisiana, on November 5, 2024 at 3:00 P.M.

The City of Lake Charles reserves the right to accept or reject any and all of the proposals and to waive formalities and technicalities. In the event any two or more of the proposals submitted are equal, the City in its discretion may select the party to whom the contract shall be granted.
