PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana, will receive sealed proposals until 2:45 P.M., April 14, 2026 in the office of the Clerk of the Council, City Hall, 326 Pujot Street, 4th Floor, Lake Charles, Louisiana. They subsequently will be opened and read for the following:

Request for Qualifications for Architectural & Engineering Design of Resilient Indoor Multi-Sports & Recreation Complex

All proposals will be evaluated on criteria such as project team organization and qualifications; key personnel qualifications; qualifying M/WBE, Veteran, or Hudson Initiative (optional); demonstrated experience and record of past performance; and other criteria more specifically defined in the RFP document. The maximum total points for each proposal are set at 100 points.

No proposals will be accepted after the above time and date. All proposals will be publicly opened and read, and canvassed in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Lake Charles, Louisiana, on April 14, 2026 at 3:00 P.M.

The City of Lake Charles reserves the right to accept or reject any and all of the proposals and to waive formalities and technicalities. In the event any two or more of the proposals submitted are equal, the City in its discretion may select the party to whom the contract shall be granted.
